Notification of results: by the end of January, all applicants will be notified of the outcome.

Each year St. Michael's Printshop invites applications from provincial, national and international artists who wish to come and work at the Printshop for a one-month period. A total of six residencies are offered during the year.

Artists are paid a residency fee and given full access to St. Michael's Printshop for a one month period. In return, artists offer one community engagement event, or workshop, and supply two prints from each edition created during the residency to SMP.

In the Zoom Pitch you will be asked to cover the questions below:

1. A detailed project proposal* that may include the following:
 1. What are the themes/ideas/interests you wish to explore during your residency?
 2. What are the processes/techniques you wish to use during your residency?
2. Artist Statement that may include the following:
 1. What are the general themes/ideas/interests/influences that you explore in your practice beyond the scope of the residency?
3. Artist Bio*
 1. Tell us a little about yourself in relation to your art practice.
 2. We welcome folks to self-identify as BIPOC and 2SLGBTQQIA+
4. A workshop proposal*
 1. An important part of our Visiting Artist Program is the workshop component. It allows the visiting artist to share their unique knowledge with our community. Please propose a 1-2 day workshop. This can range from an intro class in a medium you are comfortable teaching in to a special topic class.
